4. RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR VARIOUS COURSES
4.1 Types of Reservation in Government/Aided/KAU/KVASU/KUFOS Colleges: Out of the total seats available for the various courses, seats will be reserved for different categories as given under Clauses 4.1.1 to 4.1.5.
4.1.1 Reservation for All India Quota for MBBS/BDS Courses: Fifteen percent of the total sanctioned seats in MBBS/ BDS Courses in Govt. Medical/ Dental Colleges in the State are set apart for the allotment of the candidates by the Director General of Health Services, Government of India. [Refer Clause 4.1.11(a)]
4.1.2 Reservation for Nominees : These are the seats set apart for the nominees of the Government of India, Union Territories or other States for the various courses. [For details, refer Clauses 4.1.11 (b), 4.1.12, 4.1.13, 4.1.14, 4.1.15]
4.1.3 Reservation for Persons with Disabilities : Leaving the seats set apart under Clauses 4.1.1 and 4.1.2 above, three percent of the seats available for the state for allotment from the Entrance rank lists, for all the courses in all the Government and Aided colleges are reserved for the candidates with disabilities. [For details, refer Clause 5.3]
4.1.4 Special Reservation : These are the seats reserved for certain specific categories, for different courses. [For details, refer Clause 5.2]
4.1.5 Mandatory Reservation : Leaving the seats set apart for All India Quota, Government of India Nominees, Special reservations, Persons with Disabilities and Management Quota, the remaining Government seats for each course in Govt./ Aided/ KAU/ KVASU/ KUFOS Colleges will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle as contemplated in G.O. (P) 208/ 66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, G.O.(Ms)No. 95/ 08/ SCSTDD Dated 06.10.2008, GO(Ms) No. 10/ 2014/ BCDD Dated 23.05.2014 and as modified from time to time.

2) As per GO(Rt.)No. 1621/2017/ H\&FWD dated 08.06.2017, The reservation pattern in Government Medical College, Kollam will be as follows: State Quota-50\%, Wards of Insured Persons under Employees State Insurance Corporation-35\% (Not allotted by CEE), All India Quota-15\%
4.1.6 The total number of seats available for the different courses will be published prior to the commencement of CAP-2018.
4.1.7 Admission to all the Government seats except the seats reserved for All India Quota for MBBS/ BDS and Nominees will be made on the basis of respective rank lists/inter-se merit as may be applicable.
4.1.8 The number of seats earmarked for various categories for the different courses in Government and Aided Colleges will be finalised before CAP-2018.
4.1.9 Reservation of seats for Engineering Courses [B.Tech.] : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees, Reciprocal quota and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2) (a).
4.1.10 Reservation of seats for B.Arch. Course : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2)(a).

### 4.1.11 Reservation of seats for MBBS \& BDS Courses

(a) Reservation of seats under All India Quota:

The seats reserved under All India Quota for MBBS and BDS Courses in Government Medical/ Dental Colleges will be allotted by the Director General of Health Services, New Delhi, on the basis of the rank obtained in the NEET-UG conducted by the CBSE, New Delhi. Details of seats are given in Annexure III (2).
(b) Reservation of seats for Nominees:
(i) Nominees of the Government of India: The Government of India, subject to the eligibility conditions in clause 6, will make Nominations to these seats. The distribution of seats under this category and other details in respect of MBBS/ BDS courses are available in Annexure III (2).
(ii) Nominees from Union Territory of Andaman \& Nicobar Islands: These seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Nominations to these seats will be made by the Administration of that Union Territory and the candidates must possess the requisite qualifications as provided under Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iii) Nominees from Lakshadeep: Seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in Lakshadeep. The candidates should be sponsored by the Administration of that Union Territory and must possess the requisite qualifications as per Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iv) Nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir: One seat for MBBS will be reserved in a Govt. Medical College (by rotation every year in the order TVM, ALP, KTM, TCM, KKM, MLP and CMC) for a nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir. Candidate to this seat should be sponsored by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through the Higher Education Secretary of the State. This year, the seat will be reserved in Government Medical College, Manjeri [See Annexure III(2)].

Admission to the seats under 4.1.11(b)(i) to 4.1.11(b)(iv) above should be completed by the admitting authority by 31.07.2018. The Director of Medical Education will inform the CEE, through Government of Kerala, the un-availed seats in these categories on 01.08.2018 itself. Such seats will be reverted to the mandatory quota.
4.1.12 Reservation of seats for BHMS Course : The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories are given in Annexure IV (2).
4.1.13 Reservation of seats for BAMS Course : The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories are given in Annexure V (2). In the case of Foreign students given by ICCR, the ICCR should inform those application details before 45 days from the cutoff date of BAMS course fixed by Central AYUSH Ministry.
4.1.14 Reservation of seats for Courses under the Kerala Agricultural University : [BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.), B.Tech. (Food Engg. \& Tech)], Kerala Veterinary \& Animal Sciences University : [BVSc \& AH, B.Tech. (Dairy Technology.) and B.Tech (Food Technology)], Kerala University of Fisheries \& Ocean Studies: BFSc, B.Tech (Food Technology).
(a) The number of seats reserved for the various special reservation categories is given in Annexure VII (4).
(b) The seats available for Agriculture, Veterinary and Fisheries courses in Annexure VII (4) will be filled only with the concerned category of candidates. If students are not available in the respective category, the seats will be filled from the General quota. (Also refer to Clause 5.2.15)
(c) One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for one of the courses on rotation basis in the order of BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BVSc \& AH, BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.) and B. Tech. (Dairy Technology). This year the seat is reserved in B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.) Course. One seat is reserved for J ewish Community, for BFSc Course.
4.1.15 Reservation of seats for B.Pharm course: The number of seats reserved for Government of India nominee and Special Reservation categories in B.Pharm Course is given in Annexure VI(3)(a).
4.2 Types of reservation in Self financing Colleges: The reservation of seats in Self-financing Colleges run by institutions under Govt. control and Private Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
5. CLAIMS FOR RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

Note: (i) Claims for Special/ Mandatory reservations must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of application with supporting documents as required. The claim has to be specified in the application in the appropriate places. Claims made after the submission of application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced. The claims for Special and Mandatory reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstance.
(ii) Only candidates belonging to 'Keralite' category as defined in Clause 6.1(i), are eligible for claiming seats under Mandatory quota in Government/Aided Colleges, and Special reservation quota unless otherwise specified in the prospectus. Details of reservation of seats, if any, in Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
5.1 Reservation for Nominees: The categories of candidates who are entitled to the Central Government reserved seats for admission to MBBS/ BDS courses, and the authorities to whom applications are to be sent, are given in Annexure III (3). Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for BHMS \& BAMS courses are available in Annexure IV (2) \& V (2) respectively. Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for B. Pharm Course are available in Annexure VI (3)(b).

### 5.2 Claim for Special Reservation:

(i) Selection under special reservation categories for admission to MBBS and BDS courses

In the case of special reservation seats earmarked for MBBS \& BDS courses, which are filled on the basis of the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2018 prepared by the CEE, only those candidates satisfying the eligibility conditions as per Clauses 6 and 9.7.5(ii) will be considered.
In the case of candidates whose admissions are governed by inter-se merit list, only those candidates who figure in the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2018 as stipulated in prepara will be considered while preparing the inter-se merit list for admission to MBBS/ BDS courses.
(ii) All the candidates seeking admission under the 'Special Reservation Categories' will have to appear for the Entrance Examination concerned and find place in the respective rank list. In case the admissions are based on inter-se merit list, only those candidates who have been included in the respective rank lists will be considered for preparing the inter-se merit list.
(iii) Candidates should mention the item of reservation claimed in the relevant columns in the application and should be otherwise eligible as per Clause 6.
(iv) Candidates should attach original certificates in the prescribed format along with the printout of the application, as mentioned for each item, in support of the claim from Clauses 5.2.1 to 5.2.13.
(v) Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2 .1 to 5.2 . 14 will be made on the basis of rank in the respective rank list. Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2 .15 to 5.2 .17 will be made on the basis of the inter-se merit of the candidates in the merit list prepared for the purpose. For special reservations mentioned from 5.2.15 to 5.2.17, only those candidates who are included in the respective rank list will be considered for inclusion in the inter-se merit list.
(vi) In cases where candidates are to be allotted to the 'Special Reservation' seats of Engineering/ Architecture/ B. Pharm/ Medical/ Agriculture/ Veterinary/ Fisheries courses on the basis of inter-se merit list, the authorities concerned will forward to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, the preliminary merit list of candidates prepared on the basis of the proficiency of the candidate in the respective fields. Such preliminary proficiency list should reach the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on or before $30^{\text {th }}$ April 2018. Lists received after this date will not be entertained under any circumstance and such seats will be merged to the Mandatory reservation quota.
(vii) Seats under Special Reservation in Self-financing colleges, if available, will be notified separately. Such seats, if any, will not be shifted to Government/ Aided colleges under any circumstance. The details of Special Reservation seats earmarked in Govt./Aided Colleges are given in Annexure II (2) (a), III (2), IV (2), V (2), VI (3)(a) and VII (4).
5.2.1 Ex-servicemen Quota (XS): Applicants to this category should invariably produce along with the printout of the application, a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the military authorities or State/ Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that he/ she is the son/ daughter of ex-serviceman or an ex-serviceman himself/herself. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
5.2.2 Dependent of Defence Personnel Killed / Missing / Disabled in action (DK): This benefit will be available to one person only from the family concerned in respect of each defence person killed in action/missing in action/disabled either during war hostilities or in peace time circumstances of which are identical to activities during operational engagements. They should invariably produce a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) along with the printout of the application, obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the Military Authorities/ Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that he/ she is the son/ daughter/ widow of the defence person who was killed in action or missing in action or disabled in action. In the case of disabled personnel, the certificate should specify that the concerned person was/ is in receipt of disability pension. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
If no suitable candidate under this category is available for the concession, as per the existing order/ rules, the seats reserved for them will be given to the son/ daughter/ widow of the defence personnel who died in harness (HR), if they are otherwise eligible as per Clause 6. They should produce certificate in Annexure XIII (a) along with the printout of the application obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from Military Authority/ Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that the defence personnel had died while in service. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
If there are still no suitable candidates under this category, the seats reserved for the children/ widow of defence personnel killed in action/missing in action/disabled will be given to children of Serving Defence personnel or in their absence to ex-servicemen/ children of ex-servicemen.
Only one candidate from a family will be eligible for Special Reservation quota under Clauses 5.2.1 \& 5.2.2.

4.1.6 The total number of seats available for the different courses will be published prior to the commencement of CAP-2019.
4.1.7 Admission to all the Government seats except the seats reserved for All India Quota for MBBS/BDS Courses and Nominees will be made on the basis of respective rank lists/inter-se merit as may be applicable.
4.1.8 The number of seats earmarked for various categories for the different courses in Government and Aided Colleges will be finalised before CAP-2019.
4.1.9 Reservation of seats for Engineering Courses [B.Tech.] : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees, Reciprocal quota and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2) (a).
4.1.10 Reservation of seats for B.Arch. Course : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2)(a).

### 4.1.11 Reservation of seats for MBBS \& BDS Courses

(a) Reservation of seats under All India Quota:

The seats reserved under All India Quota for MBBS and BDS Courses in Government Medical/Dental Colleges will be allotted by the Director General of Health Services, New Delhi, on the basis of the rank obtained in the NEET-UG conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), New Delhi. Details of seats are given in Annexure III (2).
(b) Reservation of seats for Nominees:
(i) Nominees of the Government of India: The Government of India, subject to the eligibility conditions in clause 6 , will make Nominations to these seats. The distribution of seats under this category and other details in respect of MBBS/BDS courses are available in Annexure III (2).
(ii) Nominees from Union Territory of Andaman \& Nicobar Islands: These seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Nominations to these seats will be made by the Administration of that Union Territory and the candidates must possess the requisite qualifications as provided under Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iii) Nominees from Lakshadeep: Seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in Lakshadeep. The candidates should be sponsored by the Administration of that Union Territory and must possess the requisite qualifications as per Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iv) Nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir: One seat for MBBS will be reserved in a Govt. Medical College (by rotation every year in the order TVM, ALP, KTM, TCM, KKM, MLP and CMC) for a nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir. Candidate to this seat should be sponsored by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through the Higher Education Secretary of the State. This year, the seat will be reserved in Government Medical College, Ernakulam [See Annexure III(2)].
Admission to the seats under 4.1.11(b)(i) to 4.1.11(b)(iv) above should be completed by the admitting authority by 31.07.2019. The Director of Medical Education will inform the CEE, through Government of Kerala, the un-availed seats in these categories on 01.08.2019 itself. Such seats will be reverted to the mandatory quota.
4.1.12 Reservation of seats for BHMS Course : The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories are given in Annexure IV (2).
4.1.13 Reservation of seats for BAMS Course : The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories are given in Annexure V(2). In the case of Foreign students given by ICCR, the ICCR should inform those application details before 45 days from the cutoff date of BAMS course fixed by Central AYUSH Ministry.
4.1.14 Reservation of seats for Courses under the Kerala Agricultural University : [BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.), B.Tech. (Food Engg. \& Tech)], Kerala Veterinary $\&$ Animal Sciences University : [BVSc \& AH, B.Tech. (Dairy Technology.) and B.Tech (Food Technology)], Kerala University of Fisheries \& Ocean Studies : BFSc, B.Tech (Food Technology).
(a) The number of seats reserved for the various special reservation categories is given in Annexure VII (4).
(b) The seats available for Agriculture, Veterinary and Fisheries courses in Annexure VII (4) will be filled only with the concerned category of candidates. If students are not available in the respective category, the seats will be filled from the General quota. (Also refer to Clause 5.2.15)
(c) One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for one of the courses on rotation basis in the order of BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BVSc \& AH, BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.) and B. Tech. (Dairy Technology). This year the seat is reserved in B. Tech. (Dairy Technology) Course.

One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for BFSc Course.
4.1.15 Reservation of seats for B.Pharm course: The number of seats reserved for Government of India nominee and Special Reservation categories in B.Pharm Course is given in Annexure VI(3)(a).
4.2 Types of reservation in Self financing Colleges: The reservation of seats in Self-financing Colleges run by institutions under Govt. control and Private Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.

## 5. CLAIMS FOR RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE UPLOADED

Note: (i) Claims for Special/Mandatory reservations must be made by a candidate in the online application and the supporting documents shall be uploaded to the online application within the stipulated time. The claim has to be specified in the application in the appropriate places. Claims made after the submission of online application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced. The claims for Special and Mandatory reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstance.
(ii) Only candidates belonging to 'Keralite' category as defined in Clause 6.1(i), are eligible for claiming seats under Mandatory quota in Government/Aided Colleges, and Special reservation quota unless otherwise specified in the prospectus. Details of reservation of seats, if any, in Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
5.1 Reservation for Nominees: The categories of candidates who are entitled to the Central Government reserved seats for admission to MBBS/BDS courses, and the authorities to whom applications are to be sent, are given in Annexure III (3). Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for BHMS \& BAMS courses are available in Annexure IV (2) \& V (2) respectively. Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for B.Pharm Course are available in Annexure VI (3)(b).

### 5.2 Claim for Special Reservation:

(i) Selection under special reservation categories for admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses
In the case of special reservation seats earmarked for MBBS, BDS, BAMS,BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses, which are filled on the basis of the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2019 prepared by the CEE, only those candidates satisfying the eligibility conditions as per Clauses 6 and 9.7 .5 (ii) \& 9.7.5(iii) will be considered.

In the case of candidates whose admissions are governed by inter-se merit list, only those candidates who figure in the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2019 prepared by CEE as stipulated in pre-para will be considered while preparing the inter-se merit list for admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS,BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses.
(ii) All the candidates seeking admission under the 'Special Reservation Categories' will have to appear for the Entrance Examination concerned and find place in the respective rank list. In case the admissions are based on inter-se merit list, only those candidates who have been included in the respective rank lists will be considered for preparing the inter-se merit list.
(iii) Candidates should mention the item of reservation claimed in the relevant columns in the application and should be otherwise eligible as per Clause 6.
(iv) Candidates should upload required certificates in the prescribed format to the online application within the stipulated time, as mentioned for each item, in support of the claim from Clauses 5.2.1 to 5.2.15.
(v) Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2 .1 to 5.2 .14 will be made on the basis of rank in the respective rank list. Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2 .15 to 5.2 .17 will be made on the basis of the inter-se merit of the candidates in the merit list prepared for the purpose. For special reservations mentioned from 5.2.15 to 5.2.17, only those candidates who are included in the respective rank list will be considered for inclusion in the inter-se merit list.
(vi) In cases where candidates are to be allotted to the 'Special Reservation' seats of Engineering/Architecture/B.Pharm/Medical/Agriculture/Veterinary/Fisheries courses on the
basis of inter-se merit list, the authorities concerned will forward to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, the preliminary merit list of candidates prepared on the basis of the proficiency of the candidate in the respective fields. Such preliminary proficiency list should reach the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on or before $30^{\text {th }}$ April 2019. Lists received after this date will not be entertained under any circumstance and such seats will be merged to the Mandatory reservation quota.
(vii) Seats under Special Reservation in Self-financing colleges, if available, will be notified separately. Such seats, if any, will not be shifted to Government/Aided colleges under any circumstance. The details of Special Reservation seats earmarked in Govt./Aided Colleges are given in Annexure II (2) (a), III (2), IV (2), V (2), VI (3)(a) and VII (4).
5.2.1 Ex-servicemen Quota (XS): Applicants to this category should invariably upload to the online application, a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the military authorities or State/Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter of ex-serviceman or an ex-serviceman himself/herself. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
5.2.2 Dependent of Defence Personnel Killed / Missing / Disabled in action (DK): This benefit will be available to one person only from the family concerned in respect of each defence person killed in action/missing in action/disabled either during war hostilities or in peace time circumstances of which are identical to activities during operational engagements. They should invariably upload a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) to the online application obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the Military Authorities/Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter/widow of the defence person who was killed in action or missing in action or disabled in action. In the case of disabled personnel, the certificate should specify that the concerned person was/is in receipt of disability pension. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
If no suitable candidate under this category is available for the concession, as per the existing order/rules, the seats reserved for them will be given to the son/daughter/widow of the defence personnel who died in harness (HR), if they are otherwise eligible as per Clause 6. They should upload a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) to the online application obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from Military Authority/Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that the defence personnel had died while in service. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
If there are still no suitable candidates under this category, the seats reserved for the children/widow of defence personnel killed in action/missing in action/disabled will be given to children of Serving Defence personnel or in their absence to ex-servicemen/ children of ex-servicemen.

Only one candidate from a family will be eligible for Special Reservation quota under Clauses 5.2.1 \& 5.2.2.
5.2.3 Serving Defence Personnel (SD): Seats are reserved for sons/daughters of serving defence personnel from Kerala for admission to Engineering/Medical/Agricultural/Veterinary Courses. Candidates seeking reservation under this category should upload a certificate in Annexure XIII (b) to the online application obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the Officer Commanding to the effect that the candidate is the son/daughter of serving defence personnel, with details of the station where he/she works at present. Certificate obtained for other purposes will not be considered.
5.2.4 CRPF (RP): Seats are reserved for sons/daughters of personnel serving in Para Military Forces/Dependent of Paramilitary Personnel Killed/Missed/Disabled in Action including

Fifteen percent of the total sanctioned seats in BAMS/BHMS/BSMS/BUMS Courses in Government/Aided/Self-Financing colleges in the state are set apart for the allotment of candidates by the AYUSH Admission Central Counselling Committee (AACCC) on the basis of the rank obtained in the NEET-UG 2020 conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), New Delhi, (Refer Clause 4.1.13)
4.1.2 Reservation for Nominees: These are the seats set apart for the nominees of the Government of India, Union Territories or other States for the various courses. [For details, refer Clauses 4.1.11 (b), 4.1.12, 4.1.13, 4.1.14, 4.1.15]
4.1.3 Reservation for Persons with Disabilities: Leaving the seats set apart under Clauses 4.1.1, 4.1.2 above, all types of supernumerary seats sanctioned or to be sanctioned including but not limited to the seats sanctioned for reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in general category, five percent of the seats available for the state for allotment from the Entrance rank lists, for all the courses in all the Government and Aided colleges are reserved for the candidates with Benchmark disabilities. 4.1.6 The total number of seats available for the different courses will be published prior to the commencement of CAP-2020.
4.1.7 Admission to all the Government seats except the seats reserved for All India Quota for MBBS/BDS Courses and Nominees will be made on the basis of respective rank lists/inter-se merit as may be applicable.
4.1.8 The number of seats earmarked for various categories for the different courses in Government and Aided Colleges will be finalised before CAP-2020.
4.1.9 Reservation of seats for Engineering Courses [B.Tech.] : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees, Reciprocal quota and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2) (a).
4.1.10 Reservation of seats for B.Arch. Course : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2)(a).

### 4.1.11 Reservation of seats for MBBS \& BDS Courses

(a) Reservation of seats under All India Quota: Details of seats in Government Medical/Dental Colleges are given in Annexure III (2). Details of seats in Self-Financing Medical colleges will be notified separately.
(b) Reservation of seats for Nominees:
(i) Nominees of the Government of India: The Government of India, subject to the eligibility conditions in clause 6, will make Nominations to these seats. The distribution of seats under this category and other details in respect of MBBS/BDS courses are available in Annexure III (2).
(ii) Nominees from Union Territory of Andaman \& Nicobar Islands: These seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Nominations to these seats will be made by the Administration of that Union Territory and the candidates must possess the requisite qualifications as provided under Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iii) Nominees from Lakshadeep: Seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in Lakshadeep. The candidates should be sponsored by the Administration of that Union Territory and must possess the requisite qualifications as per Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iv) Nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir: One seat for MBBS will be reserved in a Govt. Medical College (by rotation every year in the order TVM, ALP, KTM, TCM, KKM, MLP and CMC) for a nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir. Candidate to this seat should be sponsored by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through the Higher Education Secretary of the State. This year, the seat will be reserved in Government Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram [See Annexure III(2)].
Admission to the seats under 4.1.11(b)(i) to 4.1.11(b)(iv) above should be completed by the admitting authority by $\mathbf{3 1 . 0 7 . 2 0 2 0}$. The Director of Medical Education will inform the CEE, through Government of Kerala, the un-availed seats in these categories on 01.08.2020 itself. Such seats will be reverted to the mandatory quota.
4.1.12 Reservation of seats for BHMS Course : The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories are given in Annexure IV (2).
4.1.13 (a) Reservation of seats for BAMS Course : The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories under All India Quota are given in Annexure V (2). In the case of Foreign students given by ICCR, the ICCR should inform those application details before 45 days from the cut-off date of BAMS course fixed by Central AYUSH Ministry. If there is any vacancy in the seats reserved in any of the categories of foreign students/Nationals of Malaysia, the same shall be filled from the other category and if there is any vacancy remaining after 01.10.2020 in the above said categories, the same shall be converted to state merit.
(b)Reservation of seats for BSMS/BUMS Courses : The seat details of BSMS/BUMS Courses including All India Quota are given in Annexure $\mathrm{VI}(1), \mathrm{VI}(2), \mathrm{VI}(2)(a)$ respectively.
4.1.14 Reservation of seats for Courses under the Kerala Agricultural University : [BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.), B.Tech. (Food Technology)], Kerala Veterinary \& Animal Sciences University : [BVSc \& AH, B.Tech. (Dairy Technology.) and B.Tech (Food Technology)],Kerala University of Fisheries \& Ocean Studies : BFSc, B.Tech (Food Technology).
(a) The number of seats reserved for the various special reservation categories is given in Annexure VII (4).
(b) The seats available for Agriculture, Veterinary and Fisheries courses in Annexure VII (4) will be filled only with the concerned category of candidates. If students are not available in the respective category, the seats will be filled from the General quota. (Also refer to Clause 5.2.15)
(c) One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for one of the courses on rotation basis in the order of BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BVSc \& AH, BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.) and B. Tech. (Dairy Technology). This year the seat is reserved in BSc. (Hons.) Agri. course.
One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for BFSc Course.
4.1.15 Reservation of seats for B.Pharm course: The number of seats reserved for Government of India nominee and Special Reservation categories in B.Pharm Course is given in Annexure $\mathrm{VI}(3)(\mathrm{a})$.
4.2 Types of reservation in Self financing Colleges: The reservation of seats in Self-financing Colleges run by institutions under Govt. control and Private Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
4.3 Reservation of Seats for Economically Weaker Sections in general category: As per the G.O (P) No.1/2020/P\& ARD dated 03.01.2020, Government have decided to implement reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in general category (EWS) to all Higher educational institutions other than minority institutions, where reservation to other backward classes are provided. In the case of courses/institutions, for which the supernumerary seats required for implementation of EWS quota are not already sanctioned by the concerned Central Council, the institution wise breakup under EWS quota will be notified separately as and when the required supernumerary seats are sanctioned.

## 5. CLAIMS FOR RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE UPLOADED

Note: (i) Claims for Special/Mandatory reservations must be made by a candidate in the online application and the supporting documents shall be uploaded to the online application within the stipulated time. The claim has to be specified in the application in the appropriate places. Claims made after the submission of online application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced. The claims for Special and Mandatory reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstance.
(ii) Only candidates belonging to 'Keralite' category as defined in Clause 6.1(i), are eligible for claiming seats under Mandatory quota in Government/Aided Colleges, and Special reservation quota unless otherwise specified in the prospectus. Details of reservation of seats, if any, in Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
5.1 Reservation for Nominees: The categories of candidates who are entitled to the Central Government reserved seats for admission to MBBS/BDS courses, and the authorities to whom applications are to be sent, are given in Annexure III (3). Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for Government BHMS \& BAMS courses are available in Annexure IV (2), V(2) and Self-Financing BAMS/BSMS/BUMS courses are available in Annexure $\mathrm{VI}(2)(a)$ respectively. Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for B. Pharm Course are available in Annexure VI (3)(b).
5.2 Claim for Special Reservation:
(i) Selection under special reservation categories for admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses
In the case of special reservation seats earmarked for MBBS, BDS, BAMS,BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses, which are filled on the basis of the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2020 prepared by the CEE, only those candidates satisfying the eligibility conditions as per Clauses 6 and $9.7 .5(\mathrm{ii}) \& 9.7 .5$ (iii) will be considered.

In the case of candidates whose admissions are governed by inter-se merit list, only those candidates who figure in the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2020 prepared by CEE as stipulated in pre-para will be considered while preparing the inter-se merit list for admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS,BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses.
(ii) All the candidates seeking admission under the 'Special Reservation Categories' will have to appear for the Entrance Examination concerned and find place in the respective rank list. In case the admissions are based on inter-se merit list, only those candidates who have been included in the respective rank lists will be considered for preparing the inter-se merit list.
(iii) Candidates should mention the item of reservation claimed in the relevant columns in the application and should be otherwise eligible as per Clause 6.
(iv) Candidates should upload required certificates in the prescribed format to the online application within the stipulated time, as mentioned for each item, in support of the claim from Clauses 5.2.1 to 5.2.15.
(v) Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2 .1 to 5.2 .14 will be made on the basis of rank in the respective rank list. Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2 .15 to 5.2 .17 will be made on the basis of the inter-se merit of the candidates in the merit list prepared for the purpose. For special reservations mentioned from 5.2.15 to 5.2.17, only those candidates who are included in the respective rank list will be considered for inclusion in the inter-se merit list.
(vi) In cases where candidates are to be allotted to the 'Special Reservation' seats of Engineering/Architecture/B.Pharm/Medical/Agriculture/Veterinary/Fisheries courses on the basis of inter-se merit list, the authorities concerned will forward to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, the preliminary merit list of candidates prepared on the basis of the proficiency of the candidate in the respective fields. Such preliminary proficiency list should reach the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on or before $30^{\text {th }}$ April 2020. Lists received after this date will not be entertained under any circumstance and such seats will be merged to the Mandatory reservation quota.
(vii) Seats under Special Reservation in Self-financing colleges, if available, will be notified separately. Such seats, if any, will not be shifted to Government/Aided colleges under any circumstance. The details of Special Reservation seats earmarked in Govt./Aided Colleges are given in Annexure II (2) (a), III (2), IV (2), V (2), VI (3)(a) and VII (4).
5.2.1 Ex-servicemen Quota (XS): Applicants to this category should invariably upload to the online application, a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer concerned to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter of ex-serviceman or an ex-serviceman himself/herself. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
5.2.2 Dependent of Defence Personnel Killed / Missing / Disabled in action (DK): This benefit will be available to one person only from the family concerned in respect of each defence person killed in action/missing in action/disabled either during war hostilities or in peace time circumstances of which are identical to activities during operational engagements. They should invariably upload a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) to the online application obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer concerned to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter/widow of the defence person who was killed in action or missing in action or disabled in action. In the case of disabled personnel, the certificate should specify that the concerned person was/is in receipt of disability pension. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
If no suitable candidate under this category is available for the concession, as per the existing order/rules, the seats reserved for them will be given to the son/daughter/widow of the defence personnel who died in harness (HR), if they are otherwise eligible as per Clause 6. They should upload a certificate in Annexure XIII (a) to the online application obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from Military Authority/Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that the defence personnel had died while in service. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted

(ii) Reservation for All India Quota for MBBS/BAMS/BSMS/BUMS Courses in Self-Financing Medical/Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani colleges:-
Fifteen percent of the seats for the admission of students to MBBS/BAMS/BSMS/BUMS Courses in Self-Financing Medical/Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani Colleges in Kerala are set apart for the allotment of candidates irrespective of their Domicile as per the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for the Entrance Examinations on the basis of the rank obtained in the NEET-UG 2021 conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) New Delhi.
See clause 4.1.11(a) and 4.1.13(a)\&(b).
4.1.2 Reservation for Nominees: These are the seats set apart for the nominees of the Government of India, Union Territories or other States for the various courses. [For details, refer Clauses 4.1.11 (b), 4.1.12, 4.1.13, 4.1.14, 4.1.15]
4.1.3 Reservation for Persons with Disabilities: Leaving the seats set apart under Clauses 4.1.1, 4.1.2 above, all types of supernumerary seatssanctioned, five percent of the seats available for the state for allotment from the Entrance rank lists for all the courses in all the Government and Aided colleges are reserved for the candidates with Benchmark disabilities. [For details, refer Clause 5.3]
4.1.4 Special Reservation: These are the seats reserved for certain specific categories, for different courses. [For details, refer Clause 5.2]
4.1.5 Mandatory Reservation : Leaving the seats set apart for All India Quota, Government of India Nominees, Special reservations, Persons with Disabilities, all types of supernumerary seats sanctioned and Management Quota, the remaining Government seats for each course in Govt./Aided/KAU/KVASU/KUFOS Colleges will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle as contemplated in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, G.O.(Ms)No.95/08/SCSTDD Dated 06.10.2008, GO(Ms) No. 10/2014/BCDD Dated 23.05.2014 and as modified from time to time.

Note: 1) As per GO(Ms) No. 46/2015/SCSTDD dated: 23.06.2015, the reservation pattern in Govt. Medical College, Palakkad (Institute of Integrated Medical Sciences, Palakkad) will be as follows: Scheduled Caste - 70\%, Scheduled Tribe - 2\%, General Merit - 13\% and All India Quota- 15\%.
2) As per GO(Rt.)No. 1621/2017/H\&FWD dated 08.06.2017, The reservation pattern in Government Medical College, Kollam will be as follows: State Quota-50\%, Wards of Insured Persons under Employees State Insurance Corporation-35\% (Not allotted by CEE), All India Quota-15\%.
4.1.6 The total number of seats available for the different courses will be published prior to the commencement of CAP-2021.
4.1.7 Admission to all the Government seats except the seats reserved for All India Quota for MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS Courses and Nominees will be made on the basis of respective rank lists/inter-se merit as may be applicable.
4.1.8 The number of seats earmarked for various categories for the different courses in Government and Aided Colleges will be finalised before CAP-2021.
4.1.9 Reservation of seats for Engineering Courses [B.Tech.] : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees, Reciprocal quota and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2) (a).
4.1.10 Reservation of seats for B.Arch. Course : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2)(a).
4.1.11 Reservation of seats for MBBS\& BDS Courses
(a) Reservation of seats under All India Quota:Details of seats in Government Medical/Dental Colleges are given in Annexure III (2). Details of seats in Self-Financing Medical colleges will be notified separately.
(b) Reservation of seats for Nominees:
(i) Nominees of the Government of India: The Government of India, subject to the eligibility conditions in clause 6, will make Nominations to these seats. The distribution of seats under this category and other details in respect of MBBS/BDS courses are available in Annexure III (2).
(ii) Nominees from Union Territory of Andaman\& Nicobar Islands: These seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Nominations to these seats will be made by the Administration of that UnionTerritory and the candidates must possess the requisite qualifications as provided under Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iii) Nominees from Lakshadweep: Seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in Lakshadweep. The candidates should be sponsored by the Administration of that UnionTerritory and must possess the requisite qualifications as per Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iv) Nominee from Jammu\& Kashmir: One seat for MBBS will be reserved in a Govt. MedicalCollege (by rotation every year in the order TVM, ALP, KTM, TCM, KKM, MLP and CMC) for a nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir. Candidate to this seat should be sponsored by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through the Higher Education Secretary of the State. This year, the seat will be reserved in Government T.D Medical College, Alappuzha. [See Annexure III(2)].

Admission to the seats under 4.1.11(b)(i) to 4.1.11(b)(iv) above should be completed by the admitting authority before the surrender of AIQ seats by the central authority concerned. The Director of Medical Education will inform the CEE, through Government of Kerala, the un-availed seats in these categoriesbefore the last phase of the CAP by the CEE. Such seats will be reverted to the mandatory quota.
4.1.12 Reservation of seats for BHMS Course : The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories are given in Annexure IV (2).
4.1.13 (a)Reservation of seats for BAMS Course :The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categoriesunder All India Quota are given in Annexure V (2). In the case of Foreign students given by ICCR, the ICCR should inform those application details before 45 days from the cut-off date of BAMS course fixed by Central AYUSH Ministry. If there is any vacancy in the seats reserved in any of the categories of foreign students/Nationals of Malaysia, the same shall be filled from the other category and if there is any vacancy remaining after 01.10.2021 in the above said categories, the same shall be converted to state merit.
(b)Reservation of seats for BSMS/BUMS Courses : The seat details of BSMS/BUMS Courses including All India Quota are given in Annexure $\mathrm{VI}(1), \mathrm{VI}(2), \mathrm{VI}(2)(a)$ respectively.
4.1.14 Reservation of seats for Courses under the Kerala Agricultural University : [BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Sc (Hons) Co-operation \& Banking, B.Sc (Hons) Climate Change \& Environmental Science, B.Tech Biotechnology, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.), B.Tech. (Food Technology)], Kerala Veterinary \& Animal Sciences University : [BVSc \& AH, B.Tech.
(Dairy Technology.) and B.Tech (Food Technology)],Kerala University of Fisheries \& Ocean Studies: BFSc, B.Tech (Food Technology).
(a) The number of seats reserved for the various special reservation categories is given in Annexure VII (4).
(b) The seats available for Agriculture, Veterinary and Fisheries courses in Annexure VII (4) will be filled only with candidates from the respective categories. If students are not available in the respective category, the seats will be filled up as General quota. (Also refer to Clause 5.2.15).
(c) One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for one of the courses on rotation basis in the order of BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BVSc\& AH, BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.) and B. Tech. (Dairy Technology). This year the seat is reserved in BVSc\& AH course. One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for BFSc Course.
4.1.15 Reservation of seats for B.Pharm course: The number of seats reserved for Government of India nominee and Special Reservation categories in B.Pharm Course is given in Annexure $\mathrm{VI}(3)(a)$.
4.2 Types of reservation in Self financing Colleges: The reservation of seats in Self-financing Colleges run by institutions under Govt. control and Private Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
4.3 Reservationof Seats for Economically Weaker Sections in general category: As per the G. 0 (MS) No.2/2020/P\&ARD dated 12.02.2020 and G.O.(MS)No.5/2020/P\&ARD dated. 03.03.2020,Government have decided to implement reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in general category (EWS) to all Higher educational institutions other than minority institutions, where reservation to other backward classes are provided. In the case of courses/institutions, for which theadditional seats required for implementation of EWS quota are not already sanctioned by the respective Central Council, the institution wise breakup under EWS quota will be notified separately as and when the required additional seatsare sanctioned.

## 5. CLAIMS FOR RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE UPLOADED

Note: (i) Claims for Special/Mandatory reservations must be made by a candidate in the online application and the supporting documents shall be uploaded to the online application within the stipulated time. The claim has to be specified in the application in the appropriate places. Claims made after the submission of online application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced. The claims for Special and Mandatory reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstance.
(ii) Only candidates belonging to 'Keralite' category as defined in Clause 6.1(i), are eligible for claiming seats under Mandatory quota in Government/Aided Colleges, and Special reservation quota unless otherwise specified in the prospectus. Details of reservation of seats, if any, in Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
5.1 Reservation for Nominees: The categories of candidates who are entitled to the Central Government reserved seats for admission to MBBS/BDS courses, and the authorities to whom applications are to be sent, are given in Annexure III (3). Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for Government BHMS \& BAMS courses are available in Annexure IV (2), V (2)and Self-Financing BAMS/BSMS/BUMS courses are available in Annexure $\mathrm{VI}(2)(\mathrm{a})$ with Annexurerespectively. Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for B.Pharm Course are available in Annexure VI (3)(b).
5.2 Claim for Special Reservation:
(i) Selection under special reservation categories for admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Co-operation \&Banking, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses
In the case of special reservation seats earmarked for MBBS, BDS, BAMS,BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Co-operation \&Banking, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses, which are filled on the basis of the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2021 prepared by the CEE, only those candidates satisfying the eligibility conditions as per Clauses 6 and 9.7.5(ii) \& 9.7.5(iii) will be considered.

In the case of candidates whose admissions are governed by inter-se merit list, only those candidates who figure in the Kerala State Rank List of NEET-UG 2021 prepared by CEE as stipulated in pre-para will be considered while preparing the inter-se merit list for admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, Agriculture, Forestry, Co-operation \&Banking, Veterinary \& Fisheries courses.
(ii) All the candidates seeking admission under the 'Special Reservation Categories' will have to appear for the Entrance Examination concerned and find place in the respective rank list. In case the admissions are based on inter-se merit lists, only those candidates who have been included in the respective rank lists will be considered for preparing the inter-se merit list.
(iii) Candidates should mention the item of reservation claimed in the relevant columns in the application and should be otherwise eligible as per Clause 6.
(iv) Candidates should upload required certificates in the prescribed format to the online application within the stipulated time, as mentioned for each item, in support of the claim from Clauses 5.2.1 to 5.2.15.
(v) Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2.1 to 5.2 .14 will be made on the basis of rank in the respective rank list. Selection to the seats mentioned from 5.2.15 to 5.2.17 will be made on the basis of the inter-se merit of the candidates in the merit list prepared for the purpose. For special reservations mentioned from 5.2.15 to 5.2.17, only those candidates who are included in the respective rank list will be considered for inclusion in the inter-se merit list.
(vi) In cases where candidates are to be allotted to the 'Special Reservation' seats of Engineering/Architecture/B.Pharm/Medical/Agriculture/Veterinary/Fisheries courses on thebasis of inter-se merit list, the authorities concerned will forward to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, the preliminary merit list of candidates prepared on the basis of the proficiency of the candidate in the respective fields. Such preliminary proficiency list should reach the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on or before $30^{\text {th }}$ July 2021. Lists received after this date will not be entertained under any circumstance and such seats will be merged to the Mandatory reservation quota.
(vii) Seats under Special Reservation in Self-financing colleges, if available, will be notified separately. Such seats, if any, will not be shifted to Government/Aided colleges under any circumstance. The details of Special Reservation seats earmarked in Govt./Aided Colleges are given in Annexure II (2) (a), III (2), IV (2), V (2), VI (3)(a) and VII (4).
5.2.1 Ex-servicemen Quota (XS): Applicants to this category should invariably upload to the online application, a certificate in Annexure XIII (a)(i) obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer concerned to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter of ex-serviceman or an ex-serviceman himself/herself. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
5.2.2 Dependent of DefencePersonnelKilled / Missing / Disabled in action (DK): This benefit will be available to one person only from the family concerned in respect of each defence person killed in action/missing in action/disabled either during war hostilities or in peace time circumstances of which are identical to activities during operational engagements. They should invariably upload a certificate in Annexure XIII(a)(ii) to the online application obtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from the Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer concerned to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter/widow of the defence person who was killed in action or missing in action or disabled in action. In the case of disabled personnel, the certificate should specify that the concerned person was/is in receipt of disability pension. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
If no suitable candidate under this category is available for the concession, as per the existing order/rules, the seats reserved for them will be given to the son/daughter/widow of the defence personnel who died in harness(HR), if they are otherwise eligible as per Clause 6. They should upload a certificate in Annexure XIII(a))(iii) to the online applicationobtained not earlier than six months from the last date of application from Military Authority/Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that the defence personnel had died while in service. The certificate should clearly show that the benefit of reservation has not been granted earlier to any member in the family. In the absence of the certificate, the claim will not be considered.
If there are still no suitable candidates under this category, the seats reserved for the children/widow of defence personnel killed in action/missing in action/disabled will be given to children of Serving Defence personnel or in their absence to ex-servicemen/ children of exservicemen.

Fifteen percent of the seats for the admission of students to MBBS/BAMS/BSMS/BUMS Courses in Self-Financing Medical/Ayurveda/Siddha/ Unani Colleges in Kerala are set apart for the allotment of candidates irrespective of their Domicile as per the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for the Entrance Examinations on the basis of the rank obtained in the NEET-UG 2022 conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) New Delhi.

4.1.2 Reservation for Nominees: These are the seats set apart for the nominees of the Government of India, Union Territories or other States for the various courses. [For details, refer Clauses 4.1.11 (b), 4.1.12, 4.1.13, 4.1.14, 4.1.15]
4.1.3 Reservation for Persons with Disabilities: Leaving the seats set apart under Clauses 4.1.1, 4.1.2 above, all types of supernumerary seats sanctioned, five percent of the seats available for the state for allotment from the Entrance rank lists for all the courses in all the Government and Aided colleges are reserved for the candidates with Benchmark disabilities. 4.1.4 Special Reservation: These are the seats reserved for certain specific categories, for different courses. [For details, refer Clause 5.2]
4.1.5 Mandatory Reservation: Leaving the seats set apart for All India Quota, Government of India Nominees, Special reservations, Persons with Disabilities, all types of supernumerary seats sanctioned and Management Quota, the remaining Government seats for each course in Govt./Aided/KAU/KVASU/KUFOS Colleges will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle as contemplated in G.O. 4.1.8 The number of seats earmarked for various categories for the different courses in Government and Aided Colleges will be finalised before CAP-2022.
4.1.9 Reservation of seats for Engineering Courses [B.Tech.]: The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees, Reciprocal quota and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2) (a).
4.1.10 Reservation of seats for B.Arch. Course : The number of seats reserved for Government of India Nominees and Special reservation categories is given in Annexure II (2) (a).

### 4.1.11 Reservation of seats for MBBS \& BDS Courses

a) Reservation of seats under All India Quota: Details of seats in Government Medical/Dental Colleges are given in Annexure III (2). Details of seats in SelfFinancing Medical colleges will be notified separately.
b) Reservation of seats for Nominees:
(i) Nominees of the Government of India: The Government of India, subject to the eligibility conditions in clause 6 , will make nominations to these seats. The distribution of seats under this category and other details in respect of MBBS/BDS courses are available in Annexure III (2).
(ii) Nominees from Union Territory of Andaman \& Nicobar Islands: These seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Nominations to these seats will be made by the Administration of that Union Territory and the candidates must possess the requisite qualifications as provided under Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iii) Nominees from Lakshadweep: Seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in Lakshadweep. The candidates should be sponsored by the Administration of that Union Territory and must possess the requisite qualifications as per Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
(iv) Nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir: One seat for MBBS will be reserved in a Govt. Medical College (by rotation every year in the order TVM, ALP, KTM, TCM, KKM, MLP and CMC) for a nominee from Jammu \& Kashmir.

Candidate to this seat should be sponsored by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through the Higher Education Secretary of the State. This year, the seat will be reserved in Government Medical College, Kottayam. [See Annexure III (2)].

Admission to the seats under 4.1.11(b)(i) to 4.1.11(b)(iv) above should be completed by the admitting authority before the surrender of AIQ seats by the central authority concerned. The Director of Medical Education will inform the CEE, through Government of Kerala, the un-availed seats in these categories before the Mop Up allotment conducted by the CEE. Such seats will be reverted to the mandatory quota.
4.1.12 Reservation of seats for BHMS Course: The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories are given in Annexure IV (2).
4.1.13 (a) Reservation of seats for BAMS Course: The number of seats reserved under nominees and special reservation categories under All India Quota are given in Annexure V (2). In the case of Foreign students given by ICCR, the ICCR should inform those application details before 45 days from the cut-off date of BAMS course fixed by Central AYUSH Ministry. If there is any vacancy in the seats reserved in any of the categories of foreign students/Nationals of Malaysia, the same shall be filled from the other category and if there is any vacancy remaining after the second phase allotment conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for AYUSH courses in the above said categories, the same shall be converted to state merit.

Kerala Veterinary \& Animal Sciences University (KVASU) : [BVSc \& AH, B.Tech. (Dairy Technology.) and B.Tech (Food Technology)]

Kerala University of Fisheries \& Ocean Studies (KUFOS): BFSc, B.Tech (Food Technology).
a. The number of seats reserved for the various special reservation categories is given in Annexure VII (4).
b. The seats available for Agriculture, Veterinary and Fisheries courses in Annexure VII (4) will be filled only with candidates from the respective categories. If students are not available in the respective category, the seats will be filled up as General quota. (Also refer to Clause 5.2.15)
c. One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for one of the courses on rotation basis in the order of BSc. (Hons.) Agri., BVSc \& AH, BSc. (Hons.) Forestry, B.Tech. (Agri. Engg.) and B. Tech. (Dairy Technology). This year the seat is reserved in B.Sc (Hons.) Forestry. One seat is reserved for Jewish Community, for BFSc Course.
4.1.15 Reservation of seats for B.Pharm course: The number of seats reserved for Government of India nominee and Special Reservation categories in B.Pharm Course is given in Annexure VI(3)(a).
4.2 Types of reservation in Self Financing Colleges: The reservation of seats in Selffinancing Colleges run by institutions under Govt. control and Private Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
4.3 Reservation of Seats for Economically Weaker Sections in General category: As per the G.O.(MS) No.128/2020/HEDN dated.20.03.2020, Government have decided to implement reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in general category (EWS) to all Higher Educational Institutions other than Minority Institutions, where reservation to other backward classes are provided.

Note: (i) Claims for Special/Mandatory reservations must be made by a candidate in the online application and the supporting documents shall be uploaded to the online application within the stipulated time. The claim has to be specified in the application in the appropriate places. Claims made after the submission of online application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced. The claims for Special and Mandatory reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstance.
(ii) Only candidates belonging to 'Keralite' category as defined in Clause 6.1(i), are eligible for claiming seats under Mandatory quota in Government/Aided Colleges, and Special reservation quota unless otherwise specified in the prospectus. Details of reservation of seats, if any, in Self-financing colleges will be notified separately.
5.1 Reservation for Nominees: The categories of candidates who are entitled to the Central Government reserved seats for admission to MBBS/BDS courses, and the authorities to whom applications are to be sent, are given in Annexure III (3). Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for Government BHMS \& BAMS courses are available in Annexure IV (2), V (2) and Self-Financing BAMS/BSMS/BUMS courses are available in Annexure VI (2) (a). Categories of candidates who are entitled for reservation under nominees for B.Pharm Course are available in Annexure VI (3) (b).
