



- Conducting awareness campaigns on anti-ragging for all students and staff.
- Developing a friendly system for new students, where they are paired with older students who can provide support and guidance.

Action Items:

Ensure that the institution's anti-ragging policy is strictly enforced, and that appropriate disciplinary actions are taken against offenders.


- The anti-ragging committee will develop a plan for implementing the new initiatives discussed in the meeting.
- The student representatives will work with the anti-ragging committee to promote awareness of anti-ragging among students.

Agenda: Anti-Ragging Precautions in College

Meeting Objective: To discuss and reinforce anti-ragging precautions and strategies in our engineering college to maintain a safe and harassment-free environment.

Meeting Minutes:

Review of Current Anti-Ragging Measures:

Ajmal m s, coordinator, provided an overview of the existing anti-ragging policies and actions. Mentioned that the college strictly adheres to the UGC and AICTE guidelines related to anti-ragging.

Proposed Precautions and Strategies:

Orientation Programs: Emphasized the need to conduct comprehensive orientation programs for new students to educate them about the anti-ragging policies and consequences.

Counseling and Support: Discussed the importance of providing counseling and support services to both victims and alleged perpetrators of ragging.

Regular Workshops: Proposed organizing regular workshops and seminars on the ill effects of ragging, its consequences, and conflict resolution.

Faculty and Staff Training: Highlighted the importance of training faculty and staff to identify and report ragging incidents promptly.

Parental Involvement: Suggested involving parents in anti-ragging awareness programs and encouraging them to keep a watchful eye on their children's behavior.

Monitoring Mechanisms: Considered implementing CCTV cameras in sensitive areas and appointing anti-ragging committees at the department level.

Timeline:

The group decided to begin implementing the proposed precautions and strategies in the next academic session.

Next Meeting:


The next meeting was scheduled after two months to assess the progress of the anti-ragging initiatives.

Closing Remarks:

The coordinator thanked all participants for their valuable input and commitment to fostering a ragging-free environment.
