Discussion Points:

To Conduct Anti-Ragging Awareness Class: It was proposed to organize an anti-ragging a wareness class for all students of the college. Placement of Faculties on College Buses: The need to have faculty members on college buses was raised as a proactive measure to prevent ragging during transportation. ME department Anti-Ragging Coordinator agreed to collaborate with the college transportation department to implement this plan effectively.

Agenda: Prevention Steps in College Campus, Canteen, Bus, Hostel and College Library

Opening Remarks:

The Chairperson opened the meeting and welcomed all attendees.

Emphasized the importance of maintaining a safe and ragging-free environment within the college premises.

Review of Previous Action Items:

The committee reviewed the action items from the previous meeting and confirmed completion where applicable.

Prevention Steps in Various Locations:

a. College Campus:

Increasing patrolling by security personnel in secluded areas of the campus. Organizing regular awareness programs and workshops on anti-ragging measures. Establishing a dedicated grievance redressal mechanism for students to report incidents confidentially.

b. Canteen:

It was suggested to increase supervision during peak hours. Displaying anti-ragging posters and helpline numbers prominently within the canteen area. Encouraging canteen staff to report any suspicious behavior immediately.

c. Bus:

Ensuring that bus drivers and staffs are trained to identify and report any instances of ragging. Implementing strict disciplinary actions against offenders on college buses. Conducting awareness sessions for students during bus rides regarding the consequences of ragging.

d. Hostel:

Increasing surveillance in hostel common areas, especially during evenings and nights. Implementing buddy systems where senior students are responsible for the well-being of junior students. Installing CCTV cameras in common areas to monitor any suspicious activities.

e. College Library:

Enforcing strict rules against loitering and group gatherings without legitimate academic purposes. Training library staff to intervene and report any instances of ragging promptly. Encouraging students to utilize library resources in a conducive and respectful manner.

The Chairperson concluded the meeting, thanking all attendees for their participation and commitment to ensuring a safe college environment.
