OUR DREAM HOUSE PROJECT

This report outlines the construction of a house for Mr. Sukumaran, son of Mr. Ayyappankutty, resident of Karinmanakkal House, Melattur Village, on his 3-cent plot under the MEA NSS 110 cell and funding from KCF Homes. The project aims to provide Mr. Sukumaran and his family with safe, affordable, and sustainable housing.

NSS unit 110 was planning to construct one house per year for a any poor family. Detail project report submitted to Principal on 05.04.2023. Mrs. Ms. Thanooja submitted a letter to the Program Officer (PO) of NSS 110, requesting the inclusion of Mr. Sukumaran in the Dream House Project. The letter outlined Mr. Sukumaran's current living situation and the challenges he faces due to inadequate housing.

KCF Home Project: -

Kochouseph Chittilappilly foundation and State NSS are signed one MOU for Construction of 100 "NSS Snehaveedu" homes per year under different NSS units. As per letter from state NSS on 31-05-2023, the main two conditions are Plot should be below 5 cent and plan area should be below 500 Sq. feet. And around 18 documents are to upload. After checking all documents KC foundation will accept or reject the application. If accepted, then agreement should be signed then installment wise fund will be transfer to the applicant account number. Maximum amount to transfer in this project is 4 Lakhs. All works should be monitor by NSS volunteers.


1. APPLICATION:-

Melatur Panjayath ward no: 14, Malappuram district. 18 documents are submitted contains Aadhar card, Ration card ,Panjayath letter , Request letter , Karam Receipt ,Aahdaram ,Possession certificate ,Land details , Permit ,Signed plan ,Photo with Aadharam , Photo In front of new house , Photo in front of old house , Bank details and Principal ,Programme officer , Volunteer secretary , volunteers Recommendations letter.

1.1 <u>Site Visit :-</u>

Volunteer Secretary and charge of this dream house project volunteer visit the site on 11-08-2023 for take measurements of existing foundation.

1.2 Final Submission of application :-

After visiting the site, make new drawing with existing foundation and application is submitted with all documents after lot of quarries. First stage submitted on 15-07-2023 and final submission on 05-10-2023.

2. Approval :-

After final submission of application, fund is sanctioned on 11-10-2023. Then same date agreement is prepared Rs 200/- and signed the sent through post and also sent in mail. First installment amount of Rs 25,000/- credited Applicant bank account on 20-10-2023.

3. **WORK** :-

3.1 Site measurements :-

After approval of project, Volunteers was visited the site on 22-10-2023 for take measurements of existing foundation. Drawled new plan based on current data.



$3.2 \quad 01/11/2023$ (Site preparation and cleaning):-

On November 1, 2023, a group of dedicated NSS volunteers undertook the task of site preparation and cleaning at Sukumaran's plot, marking a crucial step towards the construction of his new home under the Dream House project. The volunteers diligently removed debris, leveled the ground, and prepared the site for the commencement of foundation work. This voluntary effort demonstrated the spirit of community engagement and highlighted the invaluable contribution of NSS volunteers to the success of the project.



3.3 01/11/2023 (Plot Redesign and Submission to KCF):

Following the initial site measurements and, the project team identified the need for a redesign of Sukumaran's plot to optimize space utilization, enhance the functionality of the house, and ensure adherence to local building codes. On November 8, 2023, the revised plot design, incorporating the necessary modifications, was formally submitted to KCF for review and approval. The submission of the redesigned plot marked a crucial step in ensuring that the Dream House project would meet the needs and requirements of both the beneficiary family and the regulatory authorities.

3.4 <u>10/11/2023 (Contractor Engagement and Agreement):</u>

On November 10, 2023, NSS MEA110 entered into a formal agreement with Mr. Latheef, an experienced and qualified contractor, to undertake the foundation to tiling works for the construction of Sukumaran's house under the Dream House project. The agreement outlined the scope of work, the timeframe for completion, the payment terms, and the responsibilities of both parties in ensuring the successful execution of the contracted works.





3.5 **13/11/2023** (Foundation Rework Initiation):

On November 13, 2023, the construction team commenced the rework of the foundation for Sukumaran's house under the Dream House project. This rework was necessitated due to unforeseen structural issues identified during the initial construction phase. The decision to rework the foundation was made in consultation with the contractor, architects, and KCF representatives to ensure the long-term stability and safety of the house.



3.6 <u>16/11/2023</u> (Ensuring Water Access for Construction):-

Recognizing the importance of water access for the construction process, NSS Volunteers proactively purchased a motor for water pumping and its parts on November 16, 2023, at a cost of rupees 11,600/-. This initiative ensured that the construction team would have a reliable and adequate supply of water for mixing concrete, washing materials, and maintaining a clean and hygienic work environment.



3.7 16/11/2023 (Installation of Water Pumping System):

Following the purchase of a motor for water pumping and its parts on November 16, 2023, NSS Volunteers demonstrated their dedication and technical skills by installing the motor and pipelines on November 17-18, 2023. This hands-on involvement ensured that the water pumping system was properly installed, connected to the water source, and ready to provide the necessary water supply for the construction process.





3.8 <u>21/11/2023</u> (Belt Concrete Construction):

On November 21, 2023, a significant milestone was achieved in the construction of Sukumaran's house under the Dream House project with the completion of the belt concrete. The belt concrete, also known as the plinth beam, forms a crucial structural element that acts as a transition between the foundation and the upper walls of the house.
